President Ford has designated C. Robert Moore, U. S. Ambassador to Cameroon, as his Personal Representative with Rank of Special Ambassador to attend ceremonies July 12, 1975, marking the independence of Sao Tome and Principe. Representative Cardiss Collins (D-Ill.) and Representative Charles C. Diggs, Jr., (D-Mich.) have been designated by the President as members of the U. S. official delegations.
