The trip to Europe requires certain updates of your shots. The White House Physician's Office will be available to administer these shots to those who are not going to get them from a private physician. We have arranged for the Corpsman and the Nurse to be here in the Press Office on Wednesday at 12:30 p.m. -- immediately following the briefing.

The requirements are: Small pox, within three years; Typhoid, within three years; and tetnus, within three years.

Those of you who are taking camera and sound equipment should FOR YOUR OWN PROTECTION submit a list of items including manufacturer and serial number to Ray Zook prior to departure.
