NOTICE TO THE PRESSThe President's Schedule.

The President arrived at the Oval Office this morning at 7:40.

At 8:00 a.m. the President hosted a breakfast meeting with Members of Congress in the East Room. The subject was restoration of military assistance to Turkey. A total of 87 Members of Congress were invited to attend. The President made brief remarks. Also attending were the Vice President, Secretary Kissinger, Secretary Schlesinger, and other members of the White House staff.

At 10:00 a.m., the President will greet the participants of 1975 Boys Nation in the Rose Garden. The high school seniors who are from the 48 states and the District of Columbia, are in Washington from July 18 to 26 observing the operations of the Federal Government and holding a mock congress. The President will have brief remarks and there will be open coverage.

At 4:30 p.m., the National Security Council will meet in the Cabinet Room.

At 5:30 p.m., the President will greet between 800 and 900 college students who are participating in the Bipartisan Congressional Intern Program sponsored by the Senate and the House leadership on the South Lawn. The President, who was one of the original sponsors of this program, will have brief remarks.
