The following information was made available by the Press Office on July 24, 1975:

1. The President transmitted to Congress the Annual Report on the Federal Council on Aging (Release).
2. The President transmitted to Congress annual reports on six river basin commissions (Release).
3. The President announced his intention to nominate Charles J. Orlebeke to be Assistant Secretary of the Department of Housing and Urban Development (Policy Development and Research) (Release).
4. The President today announced his intention to nominate Howard D. Tipton to be Administrator of the National Fire Prevention and Control Administration in the Department of Commerce. (Release)
5. Intention to nominate Jacob M. Myerson to be Representative of the United States of America on the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations with the rank of Ambassador (Release).
6. Intention to nominate ten persons to be Representatives and Alternate Representatives to serve on the United States Delegation to the Seventh Special Session and the Thirtieth Session of the General Assembly of the United Nations. (Release)
7. Intention to nominate Albert Sherer to be Deputy Representative of the United States in the Security Council of the United Nations with the rank of Ambassador. (Release)
