PRESS POOLS

PRESS NOTE: Those manifested aboard the Presidential train to Sinaia are listed below. Only the Bucharest to Belgrade Air Force One pool will make the return train trip to Bucharest.

Others who wish to visit Sinaia should board buses in front of the Intercontinental Hotel at 7:30 a.m. Members of pools in Sinaia should be aboard. Others should be aware that the Romanian government will not permit open coverage of any Presidential event in Sinaia.

Those who wish to remain in Bucharest should meet the baggage deadline (6:30-8:00 a.m. in the lobby of the hotel) and should board buses en route the airport by 3:00 p.m.

PRESS POOL #7 - Travel pool depart Intercontinental Press Center at 7:15; Travel pool from Spring Palace to Presidential Train and board train becoming part of Press Pool #9. Members of Press Pool #7 MUST come from members of Press Pool #9.
