Aug. 4, 1975

Air Force One stopped in at Mildenhall Air Force Base (Tactical Air Command installation -- C-130 aircraft with service responsibility for C-141s) to refuel. Wheels down at 7:53 p.m.

Presidential Party met by Gen. and Mrs. Evan Rosenkrans, commander 3rd Air Force, Amb. and Mrs. Elliot Richardson, et al.

The President worked the fence, where roughly a couple hundred folks, mainly Americans, awaited with loud enthusiasm. Secretary of State Henry Kissinger also worked the fence, with loud whoops of joy, (from the crowd), and amiable boos when he paused. He kissed a couple of girls beyond the age of puberty. The party went into a VIP lounge for about 15 minutes.

Flight ~~ended~~ without major event, except for the Betty Ford interview attached and this quote from Kissinger (on Mideast prospects):

Indirect: He has urged both sides, Egypt and Israel, to keep their public statements restrained.
