NOTICE TO THE PRESS

PRESS COVERAGE OF THE PRESIDENT'S VAIL SYMPOSIUM SPEECH - AUG. 15

The Symposium will begin at 9:00 am with more than 500 persons expected to attend. The President's remarks are scheduled at 9:30 am, and the President will take questions from the audience at the conclusion of his remarks. We hope to have an advance text available late Thursday.

Because the Symposium is being held at the Eagles' Nest with the only transportation from Gondola No. 2, the following procedures will be necessary for those wishing to cover:

All photographic and sound equipment must be at the Eagles' Nest by 6:30 am. Lighting and multiple sound outlets will be provided. Gondola No. 2 cars will begin operating at 6:00 am to accommodate those with gear. Shuttle transportation from the Mountain Haus (rear entrance) to Gondola No. 2 will be available from 6 am to 7 am.

Writing press wishing to attend must board the gondola cars between 6:30 am and 7:00 am.

Note: The President's remarks, and the Q & A will be piped to the Press Center through the P.A. System and through the mult, as will the remarks of Frank Zarb at 1:30 p.m.

Gondola cars will not operate while symposium speakers are speaking.

Symposium sponsors tell us it will be impossible for them to furnish food for press attending the symposium.

A travel pool -- as posted -- will accompany the President. Assemble at the Press Center at 8:50 a.m. The pool will ride up to Eagles' Nest with the President and return with him.

Those wishing to cover other speakers at the Symposium must do so with equipment in place by 6:30 am, since it will not be possible to transport equipment to and from the Eagles' Nest while the Symposium is in progress.
