NOTICE TO THE PRESS

Solicitor General Robert H. Bork announced today in Washington that the Government will ask the Supreme Court to review the holding of the Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia in *Algonquin et al. v. FEA et al.* In a split decision the Court in that case held that the President does not have statutory authority to impose license fees on imported oil.

"This case involves interpretation on an important Federal Statute, Mr. Bork stated, and the issue should be decided by the Supreme Court."
