The President has accepted the resignation of Arnold Miller, of the District of Columbia, as a member of the President's Labor Management Committee. He was appointed on September 30, 1974.

The President has accepted the resignation of Joseph J. Gerry, of Manchester, New Hampshire as a member of the National Advisory Council on Equality of Educational Opportunity. He was appointed on January 30, 1973.

The President has accepted the resignation of John K. Tabor, of the District of Columbia, as a member of the President's Commission on Personnel Interchange. He was appointed on September 20, 1973.
