NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President's Schedule

The President came to the Oval Office at 7:40 a. m. He met with members of his staff during the morning.

At noon, a group of U. S. Secret Service Agents, who are being reassigned in the normal rotation, will meet with the President in the Oval Office for farewell calls.

At 12:15 p. m., the President will tape a message for the National Polish Alliance in the Cabinet Room.

At 2 p. m., the President will hold his regular meeting with the Vice President in the Oval Office.

At 5:30 p. m., the President will hold a meeting with the Presidential Clemency Board in the Cabinet Room. The President has signed an Executive Order which terminates the Board and reassigned its duties to other agencies and departments.

Announcements

The President has signed a memorandum for heads of departments and agencies announcing Frank G. Zarb as Chairman of the Combined Federal Campaign for the National Capital Area. This is the combined drive for the United Way and other agencies. (Copies available.)

The White House has announced that Thomas G. Loeffler will serve as Special Assistant for Legislative Affairs with the House of Representatives. (Release.)

The President has issued a statement on the death of Jack Bell. (A release was issued late Monday and is available today.)
