Thomas G. Loeffler, of Mason, Texas, will serve as Special Assistant for Legislative Affairs with the House of Representatives in the office of Max Friedersdorf. He has been a consultant since June 9, 1975.

Prior to joining the White House staff, Mr. Loeffler served as Deputy for Congressional Liaison for the Federal Energy Administration. From April 1972 to December 1974 he was Legislative Counsel to Senator John Tower of Texas. He was an attorney-advisor to the Economic Development Administration at the Department of Commerce.

Mr. Loeffler was born on August 1, 1946 in Fredericksburg, Texas. He received his B.A. degree in 1968 and his J.D. in 1971 from the University of Texas at Austin. He is a member of the Texas State Bar and the American Bar Associations.
