NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced the appointment of Harold R. Tyler, Jr., Deputy Attorney General, as a member of the Council of the Administrative Conference of the United States for a term of three years. He succeeds Leonard Garment who resigned effective December 31, 1974.

The President also designated Mr. Tyler as Vice Chairman of the Council.

The Council consists of 10 persons appointed by the President, of whom not more than one half shall be officials or personnel of Federal regulator agencies or executive departments.

The Council is chaired by Robert Armstrong Anthony, Chairman of the Administrative Conference of the United States.
