THE WHITE HOUSE

The President today announced his intention to nominate Milton L. Luger, of Albany, New York, to be Assistant Administrator of Law Enforcement. In this capacity he will head the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, Department of Justice. This is a new position created by Public Law 93-415 of September 7, 1974.

In 1960 he became Deputy Director of the New York Division of Youth and in 1966, he became the Director, serving until 1970. During 1971, he was Chairman of the New York State Narcotic Addiction Control Commission, before returning to the New York State Division of Youth as Director.

Mr. Luger was born on October 22, 1924, in Brooklyn, New York. He served in the United States Army Air Force from 1943 to 1946. He received his B.S. degree in 1950 and his M.A. degree in 1951 from New York University. He was a teacher at J.L. Mott Junior High School from 1950 to 1954 and was with the New York City Department of Correction from 1954 to 1960.

Mr. Luger resides in Albany, New York.
