NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced the appointment of Donald W. Moos, of Olympia, Washington, to be a member on the part of the United States of America, of the International Pacific Salmon Fisheries Commission. He succeeds Thor C. Tollefson, of Washington, who resigned effective April 22, 1975.

Mr. Moos is presently serving as Director of the Washington Department of Fisheries in Olympia, Washington.

The Commission was established by the Sockeye Salmon Fishery Convention of 1937 between the United States and Canada and a Protocol thereto of 1957 and the Commission is responsible for scientific investigations and regulations leading to the rehabilitation and perpetuation of the Sockeye Salmon of the Fraser River System in British Columbia.
