STATEMENT BY THE PRESIDENT

As most of you know, the U.S. had requested last month that Poland refrain from additional purchases of U. S. grain until the October crop report. Because today's report contains, as we expected, an excellent U. S. crop forecast, I have today authorized that Poland be notified that it may now resume purchases. We anticipate that their purchases will be spread out over a period of time.

With respect to future grain sales to the Soviet Union, negotiations are continuing and we hope to conclude an agreement in the near future.

Secretary Eutz will be holding a briefing in Washington at 4:30 PM going over the crop report and the Polish grain sale.
