NOTICE TO THE PRESS

At 3:15 p.m., Thursday, October 16, if the weather is favorable, the President plans to greet approximately 2,000 members of the World Peace Through Law Conference in the Rose Garden. The President will have informal remarks. We do not anticipate an advance text. The event will be open to full press coverage, with the President's remarks piped into the mult in the Press Room. If the weather is unfavorable at 3:15 p.m., the event will be canceled.

NOTE FOR CAMERAS: Because of the crowd, the press platforms will be set up at the rear of the Rose Garden with about a sixty foot throw to the podium from where the President will be speaking. For those who wish, photographers with hand-held cameras can pre-position on the roof of the West Wing. Please contact Bill Roberts if you want the roof photo.
