General Services Administration


Refunds under Renegotiation Act

For necessary expenses to carry out
Section 201(f) of the Renegotiation Act of
1951 (50 USC APP 1231(f)), \$1,000,000, to
remain available until expended.

The proposed appropriation would provide funds for the General Services Administration to make, to World War II contractors, rebate and refund payments authorized by the Renegotiation Act.

I have carefully reviewed the proposal for appropriations contained in this document and am satisfied that this request is necessary at this time. I recommend, therefore, that this proposal be transmitted to the Congress.
