NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President and President Valery Giscard d'Estaing met alone in the President's suite for 25 minutes following the President's arrival at the Chateau De Rambouillet, Rambouillet, France. The purpose of the meeting was for President Giscard to discuss with President Ford a tentative timetable for the weekend meetings.

The subject for tonight's first meeting will be economics. Subjects to be discussed at subsequent meetings will be trade, energy, monetary affairs, and other matters.

Following President Giscard's departure, President Ford met with his advisers, including Alan Greenspan, Richard Cheney and Ron Nessen to discuss the American views to be presented in the meetings.
