Betty Jo Christian, of the District of Columbia, to be an Interstate Commerce Commissioner for the remainder of the term expiring December 31, 1979, vice Willard Deason, resigned.

William I. Greener, of Virginia, to be an Assistant Secretary of Defense, vice Joseph Laitin, resigned.

Thomas C. Reed, of California, to be Secretary of the Air Force, vice John L. McLucas.
