

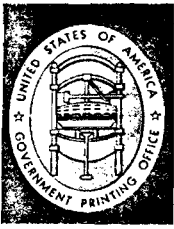
Sir:
