NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced the appointment of Carlos Romero-Barcelo, of San Juan, Puerto Rico, as a member of the National Advisory Council on the Education of Disadvantaged Children for the remainder of the term expiring September 15, 1976. He will succeed Rosalie G. Silberman who has resigned.

Mr. Romero-Barcelo is the Mayor of San Juan, Puerto Rico and is the Past President of the National League of Cities.

The purpose of the Council is to review the administration and operation of Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, including its effectiveness in improving the educational attainment of educationally deprived children, and making recommendations for its improvement and its administration and operation.
