Neither the Fords nor Rockefellers went backstage. On leaving, they did express thanks and admiration to the director, Robert M. Cooper, and his wife. The Rockefellers did not return to the White House.

The Fords returned at 10:40pm. They told poolers they thoroughly enjoyed the show, and Mrs. Ford said she well remembers the music in it. The President said, "It was great, just wonderful. Good dancing, good songs, a good evening. Good night."
