The departure times for the President's trip to New Hampshire on Thursday, February 19 are:

- 2:45 p. m. Press check-in at Andrews Air Force Base
- 3:15 p. m. Press plane departs Andrews Air Force Base
- 3:40 p. m. The President departs South Grounds via helicopter en route Andrews Air Force Base
- 4:00 p. m. The President departs Andrews Air Force Base en route Keene, N. H.
- 4:30 p. m. Press plane arrives Dillant-Hopkins Airport, Keene, N. H.
- 5:10 p. m. The President arrives Dillant-Hopkins Airport, Keene, N. H.

PRESS NOTE: Baggage will be accepted in EOB, Room 87, Thursday, until 12 noon.

PRESS NOTE: Following the events in Keene on Thursday night, the press will fly to Portsmouth, N. H. where the overnight Press Center will be located in the Holiday Inn. The Air Force One Pool will remain with the President.

The President will address a Public Forum sponsored by the Keene Jaycees in Keene, New Hampshire, at 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, February 19. The President will have an opening statement and then have a Question and Answer session for 30 to 45 minutes. Tickets are available to the public in Keene.

On Friday morning, the President will attend a reception for PFC workers, and then travel to Pease Air Force Base in Eastern New Hampshire.

At 9 o'clock a.m., the President will attend a breakfast sponsored by the Dover Chamber of Commerce. Others attending the breakfast will include members of various service organizations throughout the Southeastern New Hampshire area. The President will have remarks at the breakfast.

Following the breakfast, the President will drop by the Dover High School for brief remarks.

The President is expected to return to the White House in the mid-afternoon on Friday.
