NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today will sign and is transmitting to the Congress the Fourth International Economic Report of the President, and the Annual Report of the Council on International Economic Policy.

The Report reviews the developments in U.S. international economic policy during 1975, with particular emphasis on economic recovery, energy and food issues, new international monetary and trade arrangements, and the changing relationships between the developed and developing nations.
