(as if to say are you telling us the truth) He bactracked and said " I speak to him frequently". Nothing truly earth shaking happenned. Ford and Hussein spoke briefly after all the guests filed thru the receiving line. We exit in a rush.

Ford said he vetoed 46 bills so far and loyal hard working Republicans helped him sustain 39 of those vetoes. He said he would vetoe the Defense package if the Congress did not give him what he needs for a national defense. He said the congressional energy policy is one of delay. He asked what the Democrats are going to do about the social security deficit. " A strong and solvent social security system
