After shaking hands with members of the Wisconsin Association of Manufacturers and Commerce, the President walked down the hall to greet PFC workers in a small room. He was introduced by former Governor Warren Knowles and before shaking hands with the volunteers the President said a few words about the primary Tuesday. "We think Wisconsin is a very important State. It is significant because it will get our momentum going again and have a tremendous impact on the States that follow." The remainder of the President's remarks dealt with his efforts to restore a balance between tax payers and beneficiaries, between Federal and State and local governments and between National Security and domestic programs.
