NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced approval of the Secretary of State's recommendation of Robert Kamm, of Stillwater, Oklahoma, to be a United States member of the Executive Board of the United Nations Economic and Social Council. He will succeed Gordon H. Scherer who has resigned.

Mr. Kamm has been President of Oklahoma State University since 1966.

UNESCO is one of the specialized agencies of the United Nations. Its constitution was adopted November 16, 1945. As of March 1974, there were 131 member states.

UNESCO promotes international cooperation in the fields of education, science, mass communications, and culture.
