NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced his intention to nominate Hung Wai Ching, of Honolulu, Hawaii, to be a Governor of the United States Postal Service for the remainder of the term expiring December 8, 1981. He will succeed John Y. Ing who resigned effective October 21, 1974.

Mr. Ching is President of Panaco Inc., an investment and real estate company in Honolulu, Hawaii.

The Postal Service was created as an independent establishment of the executive branch by the Postal Reorganization Act approved August 12, 1970. The United States Postal Service began operations on July 1, 1971.
