Salaries and Expenses

The appropriations made available under this head for the fiscal year 1976 and the period July 1, 1976, through September 30, 1976, in the Public Works for Water and Power Development and Energy Research Appropriation Act, 1976 (Public Law 94-180) are hereby made available until expended.

Monies received by the Commission for the cooperative nuclear safety research program may be retained and used for salaries and expenses associated with that program and shall remain available until expended.

The first paragraph of the proposed appropriation language will make previous 1976 and transition quarter appropriations available until expended. (Appropriation language proposed in the 1977 budget includes this authority for 1977 appropriations.)

The second paragraph of proposed language will permit the Commission to use foreign government contributions to the cooperative nuclear safety research program to help cover the expenses of the program. Such contributions are made as part of bilateral agreements negotiated jointly by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and the State Department. The first such agreement has been negotiated with the Federal Republic of Germany and additional agreements are expected.
