Sir:

I ask the Congress to consider amendments to the request for appropriations for the fiscal year 1976 in the amount of \$21,627,000, and for the transition quarter in the amount of \$5,595,037 in District of Columbia funds for the operating budget of the District of Columbia. In addition, I ask the Congress to consider an amendment to the request for the capital budget for the fiscal year 1976 in the amount of \$13,622,600.

The details of the proposals are set forth in the enclosed letter from the Director of the Office of Management and Budget. I concur with his observations and comments.

I have the honor to submit for your consideration proposed amendments to the request for appropriations for the District of Columbia. The amendments include increases in District of Columbia funds in the operating budget of \$21,627,000 in fiscal year 1976 and \$5,595,037 for the transition quarter. They also include an increase of \$13,622,600 in the capital budget request.

Details of these proposed appropriation language changes and the amounts required are shown on pages five through fourteen of the enclosure to this letter. I have carefully reviewed the proposals for appropriations contained in this document and am satisfied that these requests are necessary at this time. I recommend, therefore, that they be transmitted to the Congress.
