I ask the Congress to consider, for the Department of Transportation, 1976 supplemental appropriations, amendments to appropriations transmitted in the 1977 budget, and appropriation language changes. New budget authority requests total \$188,000,000 for fiscal year 1976 and \$400,000,000 for fiscal year 1977. Reductions in requests for cash to liquidate contract authority total \$14,000,000 for fiscal year 1976 and \$69,000,000 for fiscal year 1977.

The details of these proposals are set forth in the enclosed letter from the Director of the Office of Management and Budget. I concur in his comments and observations.

I have the honor to submit for your consideration requests for fiscal year 1976 supplemental appropriations, amendments to appropriations transmitted in the 1977 budget, and appropriation language changes for the Department of Transportation. New budget authority requests total \$188,000,000 for fiscal year 1976 and \$400,000,000 for fiscal year 1977. Reductions in requests for cash to liquidate contract authority total \$14,000,000 for fiscal year 1976 and \$69,000,000 for fiscal year 1977. Projects Substituted For Interstate System Projects

For payment to the urban mass transportation fund for necessary expenses to carry out the provisions of Section 103(e)(4) of Title 23, United States Code, \$188,000,000, to remain available until expended: Provided, That such amounts as are necessary to carry out highway projects substituted for Interstate System segments may be transferred to the Federal Highway Administration.

This supplemental appropriation is necessary because the Federal-Aid Highway Act of 1976 changes the funding mechanism for projects substituted for Interstate System segments by requiring appropriation action before the funds transferred can be obligated.

This proposed amendment is necessary to reduce the amount of requested cash to liquidate contract authority because of the reduction in level of available contract authority after enactment of Federal-Aid Highway Act of 1976 and to permit funds to be used for substituted highway projects.

This amended language reduces the level of the limitation on obligations against contract authority for projects substituted for Interstate System routes to reflect funding changes in the Federal-Aid Highway Act of 1976. With the enactment of this legislation, appropriations are required for all newly substituted projects before funds are available for obligation.

The Federal-Aid Highway Act of 1976 requires the appropriation of funds for projects substituted for Interstate System routes prior to obligation. This amendment provides appropriations for amounts that were reflected in the 1977 budget request as contract authority.
