This amendment will provide funds for the staff and contract support needed to implement regulations and procedures for automobile fuel economy standards established by the Energy Policy and Conservation Act of 1975. This is a new regulatory responsibility of the Department of Transportation not anticipated during formulation of the 1977 budget and sufficient specialized staff and contract resources are not presently available. Program development must begin promptly to meet the statutory deadlines for promulgation of regulations by mid-1977.
