NOMINATIONS SENT TO THE SENATE ON JUNE 9, 1976:

General George S. Brown, United States Air Force, for reappointment as Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff for an additional term of two years.

Thomas J. Houser, of Illinois, to be Director of the Office of Telecommunications Policy, vice Clay T. Whitehead, resigned.

Richard B. Ogilvie, of Illinois, to be a Member of the Board of Directors of the United States Railway Association for the remainder of the term expiring July 8, 1976, vice William W. Scranton, resigned.

Richard B. Ogilvie, of Illinois, to be a Member of the Board of Directors of the United States Railway Association for the term of six years expiring July 8, 1982. (Reappointment)

Jules G. Korner III, of Maryland, to be a Judge of the United States Tax Court for a term of fifteen years after he takes office, vice Bruce M. Forrester, retired.
