NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The White House Press Office in Washington has made available the following information at 3:30 p. m., EDT.

1) The President has signed an Executive Order as amended, entitled "Adjusting Emergency Preparedness Assignments to Organizational and Functional Changes in Federal Departments and Agencies." The Executive Order makes certain organizational and functional changes for departmental emergency preparedness programs.

2) The President has issued a proclamation on Quotas on Specialty Steel Imports. The Proclamation makes effective June 14, 1976, three-year restraints on U.S. imports of specialty steel from foreign suppliers other than Japan, pursuant to his previous determination on March 16, 1976.
