NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced his intention to nominate Marion J. Callister, of Boise, Idaho, to be a United States District Judge for the District of Idaho. He will succeed J. Blaine Anderson who was nominated as a U.S. Circuit Judge for the Ninth Circuit on May 18, 1976.

The President today also announced his intention to withdraw the nomination of Mr. Callister to be U.S. Attorney for the District of Idaho. He has been the Court appointed U.S. Attorney since November 1975.
