8:22 p. m. Robin Roberts and Bob Lemon ride to pitching mound on golf carts for introductions to the crowd.

8:26 p. m. Robin Roberts and Bob Lemon proceed to Commissioner's Box.

Johnny Bench, National League Catcher, and Thurmon Munson, American League Catcher, move to baseline position to catch opening pitches.

8:28 p. m. THE PRESIDENT accepts a ball from Robin Roberts, and throws the first ball to Thurmon Munson. The second ball is accepted from Bob Lemon and thrown to Johnny Bench.
