The President today announced his intention to nominate five persons to be members of the Board of Directors of the Corporation for Public Broadcasting for terms expiring March 26, 1982. They are:

Clyde M. Reed, of Parsons, Kansas, Editor and Publisher, The Parsons Sun. He will succeed Frank E. Schooley, whose term has expired.

Charles W. Roll, Jr., of Lawrenceville, New Jersey, Study Director, the Gallup Organizations Inc., and President, Polls, Inc. He will succeed Thomas W. Moore whose term has expired.

Leslie N. Shaw, of Los Angeles, California, Vice President and Director of Community Development, Great Western Financial Corporation. He will succeed Virginia Bauer Duncan whose term has expired.

Paul M. Stevens, of Fort Worth, Texas, President, Radio Television Commission of the Southern Baptist Convention. He will succeed Jack Wrather whose term has expired.

The Board consists of fifteen members.
