NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President has signed H.R. 10374 - Membership on National Archives Trust Fund Board. This bill changes the membership of the National Archives Trust Fund Board.

The National Archives Trust Fund Board was established by the Act of July 9, 1941, to receive and administer gifts or bequests for the benefit of, or in connection with, the National Archives, its collections, or its services.

The bill will alter the membership of the National Archives Trust Fund Board by substituting the chairman of the House Committee on Government Operations for the chairman of the House Post Office and Civil Service Committee as a member of the Board.

The President has signed S. 2642 - Ninety Six National Historic Site, South Carolina. This bill establishes the Ninety Six National Historic Site in South Carolina and authorizes appropriations of not more than \$320,000 and \$2,463,000 for land acquisition and development, respectively.

S. 2642 will establish the Ninety Six National Historic Site comprising not more than 1,120 acres in the State of South Carolina. The bill will authorize the Secretary of the Interior to acquire lands, waters, and interests, therein by donation, purchase, or exchange although State or local lands could be acquired only by donation. The site would be administered as a unit of the National Park System.
