NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced his intention to nominate Kenneth K. Hall, of Charleston, West Virginia, to be a United States Circuit Judge for the Fourth Circuit. He will succeed John A. Field, Jr., who has retired effective April 1, 1976.

Since 1971, Mr. Hall has been the United States District Judge for the Southern District of West Virginia after having served as Hearing Examiner for the Bureau of Hearings and Appeals at the Social Security Administration during 1970-71.
