NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President will depart from Vail around 10:00 a. m. on Sunday, August 29. The President will travel from Grand Junction to West Yellowstone Airport, where he will board a helicopter and travel to Old Faithful in Yellowstone National Park. There the President will participate in a public event and offer brief remarks. The event will take place at approximately 1 p. m. , but the exact times will be finalized later in the week.

Following the event at Old Faithful, the President will visit the Canyon Ranger Station, where he served over 40 years ago. It is expected that several of the Rangers who he served with will be on hand to greet the President. The President is expected to depart West Yellowstone at 3:30 p. m.

At approximately 4:30 p. m. Air Force One will arrive at Ellsworth Air Force Base in Rapid City, South Dakota for a refueling stop. The President's arrival will be open to the public and base personnel. He is expected to depart Rapid City at approximately 5:30 p. m. and arrive back at Andrews Air Force Base at 10:30 p. m.
