Salaries and Expenses

For an additional amount for "Salaries and expenses", \$3,500,000, to remain available until expended.

This request will provide funds for the White House Conference on Library and Information Services. The Conference will develop recommendations for the improvement of services provided by the Nation's libraries and information service centers. It was authorized by Public Law 93-568. These funds will be used for financial assistance to the States in preparation for the national conference and for staff for the Commission.
