NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced the appointment of Charles W. Robinson, Deputy Secretary of State, to be a member of the Board of Governors of the American National Red Cross for a term of three years. He succeeds Robert S. Ingersoll who resigned as Deputy Secretary of State effective March 31, 1976.

Mr. Robinson has been Deputy Secretary of State since April 7, 1976.

The American Red Cross is the instrument chosen by the Congress to help carry out the obligations assumed by the United States under certain international treaties known as the Geneva or Red Cross Conventions. A fifty member Board of Governors directs the activities of the American Red Cross.
