

FEDERAL PRISON SYSTEM

Salaries and Expenses, Bureau of Prisons

For an additional amount for "Salaries and expenses, Bureau of Prisons", \$1,900,000, to be derived by transfer from the appropriation "Buildings and facilities".

This request for transfer authority is required to provide funds to lease and operate a 400-bed minimum security prison facility located in Otisville, New York.
