NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced his intention to nominate Glen M. Williams, of Jonesville, Virginia, to be United States District Judge for the Western District of Virginia. He will succeed Ted Dalton who is retiring.

Mr. Williams has been in the private practice of law since 1947. He has also served as Commonwealth Attorney for Lee County and is a former member of the Virginia State Senate.

After attending Milligan College and receiving his A.B. degree in 1940 and his LL.B. degree from the University of Virginia in 1943, he served in the United States Navy until 1946.

Mr. Williams is married to the former Jane Slemp and they have four children.
