NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced the appointment of Jack Ravan, of Dunwoody, Georgia, as a Commissioner representing the United States Government on the Ohio River Valley Water Sanitation Commission. He succeeds Francis T. Mayo who has resigned to become Director of the Environmental Research Laboratory for the Environmental Protection Agency. Mr. Ravan has been Regional Administrator of EPA's Region IV.

The Ohio River Valley Water Sanitation Commission consists of three Commissioners from each of the signatory states whose appointments are made by their states according to the laws of that state and three Commissioners representing the United States who are appointed by the President.

The Headquarters for the Commission are located in Cincinnati, Ohio.
