NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced his intention to nominate William D. Rogers, of Great Falls, Virginia, to be United States Alternate Governor of the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development for a term of five years; United States Alternate Governor of the Inter-American Development Bank for a term of five years and until his successor has been appointed; and United States Alternate Governor of the Asian Development Bank. He will succeed Charles W. Robinson who became Deputy Secretary of State on April 7, 1976.

Mr. Rogers has been Under Secretary of State for Economic Affairs since June 16, 1976. He joined the Department of State as Assistant Secretary of State for Inter-American Affairs in October 1974.
