

General Services Administration


Refunds under Renegotiation Act

For necessary expenses to carry out section 201(f) of the Renegotiation Act of 1951 (50 U.S.C. app.1231(f), \$1,000,000 to remain available until expended.

The proposed appropriation request is for the General Services Administration to make rebate and refund payments to World War II contractors which may be required under the Renegotiation Act.

I have carefully reviewed the proposal for appropriations contained in this document and am satisfied that this request is necessary at this time. I recommend, therefore, that this proposal be transmitted to the Congress.
