POOL REPORT #2 (Cont.) - Residence to Walnut Street Theatre
and Return.

The President came out of the Barclay House and was dressed in a dark, charcoal blue suit, pale blue shirt with dark blue necktie with maroon or wine pattern. The President had a microphone clipped to his tie just like a tie clip. He had light makeup.

He was driven to the 9th Street Stage entrance of the Walnut Street Theatre and arrived at 3:55 p.m. Pool was barred from entering. President left Theatre at 4:25 p.m., smiling broadly and waving to a crowd of about 200 people gathered outside, most of them in front of the Jefferson Hospital. He said "thank you, thank you". Would not answer pool reporters' questions as to how it would go tonight. He was driven back to the Haas home. When asked how it was going the President answered "great."
