For an additional amount for "Payment to the Postal Service Fund" for fiscal year 1976 and for the period July 1, 1976, through September 30, 1976, \$500,000,000.

For an additional amount for "Payment to the Postal Service Fund" for fiscal year 1977, \$500,000,000.

As authorized by the Postal Reorganization Act Amendments of 1976, the requested funds would be used to reduce the accumulated operating indebtedness of the U.S. Postal Service.
