THE WHITE HOUSE

The President has announced his intention to nominate two persons to be members of the National Commission on Libraries and Information Science for five year terms. They are:

Robert W. Burns, Jr., of Ft. Collins, Colorado, Assistant Director of Libraries for Research Services, Colorado State University. Mr. Burns succeeds Andrew A. Aines, whose term has expired.

Gloria Sepulveda-Vazquez, of Lansing, Michigan, Reference and Reader Services Librarian, Lansing Community College. She succeeds Catherine D. Scott, whose term has expired.

The Commission consists of 14 members appointed by the President for terms of five years and the Librarian of Congress.

The Commission was established to develop and recommend overall plans for the provision of library and information services adequate to meet the needs of all the people of the United States.
